Airgun: Alex Modic: excused

Archery: The winter league is over. The banquet is scheduled for March 30. We had 62 shooters, 20 new shooters. Sundays are getting busier, depending on the weather. League shooters are coming out to practice. Some local businesses are advertising for us. Youth night will be held on April 21st (Friday night). The Spring league will be starting soon. The trails are passable, but the water is a little high. New inserts are needed for the animal targets. We're looking at about 13 inserts and 2 replacement animals. More information will be coming.

Shotgun: Bill Lerch: February was up 130% from last year. The new 5 stand building and selling shot seem to help drive revenue. We are looking for a new cashier.
